LIMETWISTER stalked the pace racing three to four wide, bid into the far turn, dropped back a bit into the lane then rallied late to collar the leader and prevail late. STEVIE'S SQUEEZE stalked the pace from three wide, moved inside rivals entering the lane then was bumped turning for home as a rival came in, moved clear leaving the furlong grounds then could not contain the winner late. ITCHE DEANA stalked the pace racing four wide to bid through the far turn then weakened some while six wide into the lane. LIZAS DIAMOND made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail, came in on STEVIE'S SQUEEZE to bump that one turning for home then weakened in the final furlong. SILVERLAKE PATTY was forced out and clipped heels as a rival bore out in the first turn, recovered to move up five wide but could not threaten. MANGO PIE was shuffled back at the break, saved ground to make a mild bid heading up the backstretch and weakened. SHEZA POSSEBILITY got out in the first turn to force a rival wide, fanned six wide into the backstretch and was outrun. LASHING LASER chased the pace from four wide and tired.
