Footnotes

BELVER came out in the first turn to bump with LEAVIN EVEN, followed the pace from three wide to bid through the far turn and edged clear under steady handling. KENTUCKY THUMBS UP dropped back early, rallied inside through the far turn then angled four wide nearing the lane and closed with a good late run but could not reach the winner. RAFFY was on the pace from outside ALPHABET ACADEMY to move to the front in late backstretch, continued with the lead into the lane then could not handle the winner and lost the place late. FRIENDLY INCENTIVE settled back while saving ground in the first turn, moved four and five wide in the far turn fan seven wide for the drive and could not reach the top ones. REDNECK HEARTBREAK stalked the pace racing five wide then lacked a final closing response while six wide into the lane. MR. MCGAUNASH trailed early while saving ground, moved outside in the far turn to move up four and five wide but could not threaten. LORD OF TRICKS tucked in going to the first turn to save ground, remained in reach to upper stretch and weakened. LEAVIN EVEN was bumped in the first turn, stalked the pace from four wide and tired. PARAGRIN was six wide in the first turn and tired. ALPHABET ACADEMY contested the pace for a half mile from along the inside and tired.
