Footnotes

DECA saved ground while in reach of the pace, moved out on the far turn to rally five wide into the lane, closed while drifting in some late and narrowly prevailed. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD tracked the pace racing three to four wide, bid in late backstretch to move clear nearing the lane while in the five path then just failed to last. KING FARHA was well back racing three and four wide, rallied six wide into the lane, closed then altered course inside rivals as the winner drifted in and narrowly missed. The rider of KING FARHA lodged a claim of foul alleging interference against the winner which was not allowed. AHBUDD sped clear racing out from the rail to open a good lead in the first turn, resisted through the far turn then held well in the lane but was outfinished for position. NORTH OF TIME was five wide in the first turn, moved up outside but could not threaten late. MR. PINSTRIPE saved ground and moved up in the lane but could not threaten. MY SON JORDAN stalked the leaders racing four to six wide and weakened. PARTNER'S WONDER saved ground and failed to mount a bid. STARSOVERPARADISE was four to six wide in the first turn and tired. ZACK CAPE stalked the pace from along the inside and tired.
