Footnotes

DARK MATTER forced the early pace outside COLOR OUT to bid into the far turn, dueled inside NOT SO WILD through that bend and the lane and held gamely to just keep that one safe. NOT SO WILD stalked the pace from four and five wide to bid into the far turn, dueled outside the winner the remainder and could not get by. BOLD ROAR was four and five wide through the first turn, remained outside to the far turn, angled in nearing the lane and closed a bit late. AVELINA'S TICKET saved ground to the far turn, angled four wide and made a mild late run. NEWTONS THEORY saved ground and moved up through the lane while not a threat. FOUL STUFF saved ground through the first turn, angled four wide heading up the backstretch but lacked a rally. COLOR OUT showed early speed racing out from the rail and weakened. BOLD FURY stalked the leaders from three wide and weakened. DA BADA BING was always back.
