TOP OF THE HERD bumped with a rival at the break, settled early racing three wide, moved outside STEP N'FETCH to bid and move clear into the far turn, drew off in that bend then held the margin under mild urging. COBLE AVENUE saved ground while back off the early pace, rallied in the far turn then angled five wide nearing the lane and closed but could not reach the winner. DEVIL DARE YA stalked the pace racing four to five wide, angled six wide into the and moved up but could not threaten late. WINDY RUSH bumped with a rival at the break, stalked the pace from four wide and lacked a solid bid. OKLAHOMA SON saved ground in good position to late backstretch then weakened from three wide in the far turn. STEP N'FETCH showed the most early speed to gain the inside going to the first turn, continued with the pace to late in the far turn and had little left. ROYAL ON followed the pace racing three to four wide and weakened. POWDER RIVER CAT was in tight and steadied off heels while in traffic in the first turn then tired racing three to four wide. HERE COMES LUC dropped far back off the pace while saving ground and never threatened. H K'S VICTORY dropped far back early racing outside HERE COMES LUC and never threatened.
