Footnotes

OLD CLYDE moved up five deep to challenge heading up the backstretch, dueled outside CLUEMASTER through the far turn then moved clear late while drifting beyond midtrack in deep stretch. CLUEMASTER moved up four and five wide to challenge in late backstretch from inside the winner, dueled that one through the turn then could not match strides late. BRICK CREW stalked the pace in good position racing two to three wide and could not produce the needed late effort. CAMARADERIE moved up four and five wide going to the far turn then had no further response. HEYL contested the pace from outside SUPER J R, angled in when clear of that rival going to the far turn but had little left nearing the lane. SECO EXPRESS moved up four wide while not a threat. CHOSEN WORDS was always back racing five and six wide throughout. MFAZI was in good position racing three and four wide then steadied from between rivals as the top pair made the bids into the far turn and weakened. SUPER J R contested the lead from inside SUPER J R, gave way in the far turn and pulled up in distress but walked off under his own power. ABSOLUTELY LIT saved ground and was outrun.
