BLUE MALIBU pressed the pace, gained command down the backstretch, was challenged through the far turn, dug in and prevailed in a game effort under strong pressure. COLOR OUT stalked the pace, moved up three wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to just miss. JUNGLE RAJ was allowed to settle early, raced three wide and never was a serious threat. DOUG stalked the pace from the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. COMEONLITTLEMAN raced four wide in the lane and never menaced. COUNT COUP showed good speed and tired. CRAFTMASTER raced three deep and never menaced. BOOTDIM saved ground and never menaced. GOLD GUY showed little.
