### Footnotes

MOON ODYSSEY broke into the gate and came away slowly, was unhurried while settling outside, moved three and four wide through the far turn then was taken beyond the middle of the track as MONOJET drifted out and collared that one in the closing stride. MONOJET pressed the pace from outside CITY SLICKER to the far turn, lost some ground while coming out into the lane then continued to drift wide while getting to the front in deep stretch but could not hold the winner safe. CITY SLICKER bumped with a rival at the start, was on a short lead from inside MONOJET to edge clear into the stretch then could not sustain the run after leading to deep stretch. BIG DOG DADDY saved ground to the far turn, angled outside the top ones through the lane and could not produce the needed late run. STRING OF DIAMONDS bumped with CITY SLICKER and was shuffled back at the start, chased the leaders from two or three wide and had no bid. THUNDERINO saved ground in reach of the leaders early and tired.
