MONSIEUR DANSEUR settled back off the early pace racing outside, moved closer going to the far turn then fanned seven wide into the stretch and closed determinedly to prevail in the closing jump. MAN FROM LORADO took some awkward steps while coming away slowly, moved up four wide in the far turn then fanned six wide into the lane and closed to lead late but just missed. FEEDING FRENZY saved ground throughout, bid to near even for the lead turning for home but could not sustain the run. HOOLIGAN saved ground and moved up through the lane but could not threaten the top ones late. HERO TAKES IT ALL was on the early pace from between rivals, settled back to bid four wide through the far turn and weakened from five wide into the stretch. GRAND CHEROKEE contested the pace from along the inside and weakened in the lane. BEN WON'T TELL was on a pressured lead throughout and had little left for the drive.
