### Footnotes

FLYINTHEPOLARROUTE was with the leaders while four wide, moved five wide nearing the lane to bid into the stretch and wore down GAMBLING LADY LUCK to edge clear late. GAMBLING LADY LUCK was taken back at the start and angled out to be five and six wide in the first turn, challenged in early backstretch to move clear in the far turn then could not contain the winner late. SHE AROSE was with the leaders while along the inside to late backstretch, took back and angled out four wide in the far turn and regained position but could not threaten the top pair. DIVA IN TRAINING improved her position racing three wide but had no closing bid. WYALAYA contested the lead of the closely bunched group to the far turn while three and four wide and weakened. DIAMOND DID IT contested the early lead racing out from the rail and tired nearing the lane.
