Footnotes

SAWYOUINADREAM was five wide in the first turn while off the early pace, settled outside to move closer going to the far turn, continued five wide in that bend to bid into the lane and edged clear late. ROSE ROYCE contested the pace outside ROSE ROYCE to edge clear through the far turn then could not handle the winner through the closing sixteenth. WINE TASTING ROOM settled back off the pace racing four wide, moved out to rally five and six wide through the far turn into the lane and moved clear for third but could not threaten the top pair. LYNAE DAWN moved up racing three wide but could not threaten late. DEVIL WATER saved ground through the first turn, angled out four wide heading up the backstretch then swung widest into the lane and improved position. PREMIER EDGE followed the pace racing three to four wide and weakened. KONGO PAILETTE stalked the pace from four wide then lacked a rally while six wide into the lane. BRAND J C was just off the leaders from along the inside and weakened. THUNDER HOOKEY contested the pace racing inside ROSE ROYCE and out from the rail to the far turn and weakened.
