SCHOOL'S OUT was four and five wide outside rivals into the first turn while showing speed, settled back four wide, rallied going to the far turn to bid nearing the lane then moved clear under steady handling. C. O. AL contested the pace inside rivals through the first turn, continued to duel with BLACK JACK VISION up the backstretch to the far turn, briefly resisted the winner but could not match strides. PRIMISTALLA was void of any early speed while well out in the track, rallied in the far turn then continued to move up from midtrack in the lane. BLACK JACK VISION contested the lead between rivals early, continued to duel from outside C. O. AL heading up the backstretch then tired in the lane. PEDERNALES tucked inside on the first turn to save ground, made a mild bid at the leaders into the far turn but tired. PRIMAL ROCK was between rivals as four horses entered the first turn together, continued from three and four wide and tired. CHUNK dropped back after the first turn, appeared to lose action in the far turn and was far back.
