HARVIN ROBINSON settled off the early pace racing out from the rail, rallied to contention going to the far turn while inside rivals, angled out in that bend to challenge five wide into the lane and drew off while drifting late over the heavier going. I'M THE LAW made the pace on a clear lead racing in three to four path then offered no resistance to the winner while holding clear for his position. NERVY was five and six wide through the first turn, rallied to contention heading up the backstretch to bid through the far turn and had no late run. EDGE OF HEAVEN tucked in early while trailing, moved up while angling out in the far turn to come seven wide into the lane and could not threaten late. ROYAL ROSSINI stalked the leaders racing about the four path and tired. DOUGLAS EXPRESS was six and seven wide in the first turn, remained near the back then angled in through the far turn and tired while moving past beaten ones. SIGN ME UP stalked the leaders from the five path and tired. CHATHAM BARS tracked the leader from the four path and tired.
