Footnotes

RED HEADED WOMAN saved ground in the first turn then angled outside PRINCESS TAO passing through the stretch for the first time, moved from the five path to challenge and move clear going to the far turn then drew off under mild encouragement. RECOVERY GIRL saved ground racing out from the rail, moved to the inside to challenge into the far turn then could not go with the winner nearing the lane while regaining position late. FAST CITY GIRL settled in good position racing in the four to five path, ranged up outside the leaders to loom a threat going to the far turn then could not sustain the run into the lane. BRAHMS SONG was two to four wide in the opening half mile, made a mild four wide move heading up the backstretch and weakened. SAMI'S SONG settled off the pace racing out from the rail the moved up along the inside through the far turn but could not threaten. PRINCESS TAO moved to a clear lead racing in the three to four path for a half mile and tired in the far turn. MELODY RUTH failed to mount a rally racing four to five wide. DIANNA'S D. D. stalked the pace racing four to five wide and tired.
