MIDNIGHT KITTY moved to the front and established position well off the rail, remained in the three to four path throughout, shook off a challenge from CALL ME BUBBA through upper stretch and moved clear again steady handling. CALL ME BUBBA floated out a bit in the first turn then was bumped as another rival came back entering the backstretch, bid to near even with the winner nearing the lane but could not match strides late. MAGNETIC JAZZ settled back off the pace racing outside, rallied four and five wide in the far turn and was well clear for position while not a threat. SIX PACK JACK hesitated at the break, saved ground and moved up going to the far turn but had no late rally. TAX SCRATCH FEVER was four to six wide through the first turn while outside the place horse, lugged in straightening into the backstretch and bumped with that one, followed the leaders to the far turn and tired. GRANDMA JOSIE saved ground, weakened then lugged in upper stretch. BARTHELO trailed racing out from the rail and lugged in midstretch. EMBER LILLY was four to six wide through the first turn and tired.
