CHASIN THE WIND dueled outside S C KING on a solid pace while kept about the three or four path, edged clear in midstretch then was kept to steady pressure to remain well clear. GLORIOUS FUTURE stalked the pace from three and four wide to move nearest the leaders through the far turn, could not go with the winner but moved clear for his position late. S C KING dueled inside the winner while out from the rail, could not go with that one in upper stretch and weakened late to lose the place. FIRST CLASS BRASS broke a step slow then failed to threaten while saving ground. CORK THE BARBER was three or four wide and failed to produce a bid. BIG RED FANTASY tired racing three and four wide.
