MORRIS BORIS pressed the pace from the outside, raced three deep in the lane and drew off in the final stages to be clear under all out pressure. MITT showed good speed from the inside and finished second best. CASE ON ICE was allowed to settle early, raced three wide and showed good late interest. K. BOY pressed the pace and weakened. RAINY DAY AFFAIR raced evenly and had no rally. BIG TREAT saved ground and never menaced. BAH SHERT was bumped at the start, raced three deep and never was a factor. THETOTALPACKAGE failed to sustain a bid. IKE TIME raced five wide into the upper stretch and never menaced.
