Footnotes

SUMMER JONES was in a bit tight going to the first turn and dropped back, stalked the leaders from three wide to rally four wide into the lane then moved clear under steady handling. MANDOORULE stalked the pace racing two to three wide, moved inside through upper stretch and closed up the rail but was too late. LEAVIN EVEN moved to a clear lead racing out from the rail in the first turn, vied to upper stretch and had little left for the drive. ALPHABET ACADEMY tracked the pace from outside LEAVIN EVEN to bid heading up the backstretch then could not sustain the run in the lane. SUNSHINE SUPERMAN saved ground and lacked a rally. LOTTA CHROME followed the pace racing four to five wide and tired. MACHUPECHI stalked the pace from four wide for a half mile and tired.
