EWING TIGER settled just off the leaders racing out from the rail, moved four wide into the far turn to launch his rally, came six wide into the lane and rallied to be moving clear late. KING TYMATT moved to a clear lead racing out from the rail in the first turn, continued off the inside to edge clear into the lane then could not contain the winner's late run while just holding the place. SCENIC SHADOW dropped back off the pace racing off the rail, ran up into traffic as the field bunched into the far turn and briefly awaited room, moved four wide for the drive and closed but came up short. ITTAKESTWOBABY was along the inside in good position to make a mild bid into the far turn then lacked the needed final response. NASTFASTY stalked the leaders racing four wide then continued evenly while five wide into the lane. MATTCIELO tracked the pace from outside and weakened in the lane. MORTRUMP saved ground and was outrun.
