Footnotes

BOOTDIM settled back off the pace racing four wide, was bumped as a rival came in going to the far turn, continued outside into the lane then angled outside the leaders while giving a good late run to prevail in the closing yards. SECO EXPRESS stalked the pace from along the inside, angled three wide going to the far turn with his bid, vied through deep stretch and narrowly missed late. GLORY BE WILD was just off the early leader racing three and four wide, made his bid with the top pair through the far turn then was outfinished late in the blanket finish. EL INTOCHABLE saved ground while following the early pace, remained in good position then lacked room and altered course outward behind a tiring rival and could not regain his bid. CHIEF FAST CAT sprinted a commanding early lead while gaining the inside and tired through the lane. TIDAL STORM was checked after a furlong as rivals angled in then took up off heels early in the first turn, moved four and five wide then lunged in going to the far turn to bump with the winner and lacked a further response. BUTABINBUTABOOM began to lunge as the gate open and left himself well behind the field then was always back. UNUSUAL HARRY was pulled up in the far turn but walked off under his own power.
