Footnotes

HONKYTONK STOMP gained a short lead racing out from the rail in the first turn, continued in the two to three path, was challenged by BUMPER going to the far turn, dueled that one through the bend then kicked clear in the closing furlong to draw off under urging. BOXERS OR BRIEFS settled back off the pace racing four wide, rallied through the far turn to swing six wide into the stretch and closed well to gain the place late. BUMPER broke inward but quickly recovered to track the pace from outside the winner, moved to that one entering the far turn to duel into the stretch then came up empty in the final sixteenth and lost second late. CAT RULER chased the leaders while racing out from the rail and lacked a solid closing response. BELOIT KAN TOO stalked the pace from outside to the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. NERVY was shuffled back at the start as a rival broke in, saved ground and never threatened.
