Footnotes

SHADE ON settled back off the pace racing three and four wide, rallied through the far turn then angled five wide into the lane and offered up a strong late surge to collar the leader and quickly move off. RARE CRYSTAL tracked the pace from four wide to bid through the far turn and move well clear into the lane then could not handle the winner's late run. HIWAY SIXTY WEST made the running on a short lead from about the three path then had little left on entering the stretch. PRETTY LIL PENNY was never far back racing three to four wide, moved inside to challenge through the far turn then weakened in the drive. POSSIBLE saved ground and tired. OPERATOR ERROR was five and six wide through the first turn, dropped back heading up the backstretch and gave way.
