Footnotes

THE BATISTA BOMB was on the pace while racing out from the rail, moved closer to the rail going to the far turn while settling back, remained in striking distance then rallied back gamely through the lane to collar BLUMIN ATTITUDE in the closing jump. BLUMIN ATTITUDE moved up outside the leaders in early backstretch to make his bid, kicked clear into the stretch then continued gamely but could not keep the winner safe. SKWHIRL settled back off the pace racing outside, made his run from four and five wide through the far turn into the lane and closed well but could not run down the top pair. HESO was just off the early pace of the winner while out three or four wide, made his bid with BLUMIN ATTITUDE heading up the backstretch then came up empty when asked for his best in the lane. LARRYLARRYLARRY was back off the pace racing out from the rail, angled four wide going to the far turn but failed to mount a bid.
