WARLOCK WARRIOR contested the early pace from between rivals to kick clear in late backstretch, drew off into the lane then held a safe margin under steady handling in the lane. KORONA KAT contested the early pace from inside rivals racing out from the rail, angled out into the lane and held position. B G TOP YANKEE settled back off the pace racing three wide, ran up behind a wall of rivals late in the far turn and bumped with MARSHALL DILLION as that one was tiring, moved inside nearing the lane and could not reach the top pair. BARON SLEW was void of any early speed to drop far back while racing outside and rallied widest into the lane. FLEXTHEGOLDENPIPES lacked a bid racing four to five wide. PAJAMIANO angled five wide heading up the backstretch and failed to threaten. PLANTOBEREADY stalked the pace racing three to four wide and weakened. MARSHALL DILLION contested the early pace outside rivals, tired through the far turn and was bumped late in that bend.
