LITTLE STOGIE dueled on the pace inside BELOIT KAN TOO while about the three path, edged clear through midstretch then held safe late as CHERISHISTHEWORD made his late run. CHERISHISTHEWORD leaned into the gate and came away slowly, dropped back off the pace racing outside, rallied four and five wide through the far turn into the lane and closed well late to narrowly miss. BELOIT KAN TOO dueled from outside the winner to late in the far turn then came up empty in the closing furlong. FIVE ALARM saved ground and failed to mount a solid closing bid. ABSOLUTELY LIT showed early speed racing out from the rail, angled out heading up the backstretch and tired. RAPID JACK was not a threat racing four and five wide.
