**Footnotes**

TOP OF THE HERD tracked the early leaders then settled back just a bit to stalk four wide, rallied five wide into the lane and closed late to be along in time. KIMURA contested the pace outside MISTER THAYER throughout, continued well in the lane but could not contain the winner. MISTER THAYER contested the pace racing out from the rail and inside KIMURA, continued well in the lane but was came up short in the blanket finish. MATT N MITCH saved ground in good position just off the pace but weakened. QUALITY MIRJAH stalked the leaders racing four to five wide and weakened. SHOW YOUR FACE settled in just off the leaders while three to four wide and tired through the far turn.
