TARTAR SAUCE settled just off the dueling leaders early, moved four wide to challenge into the far turn, edged clear turning for home and held safe under steady handling. STELLAR PRINCESS was bumped and shuffled back at the start, angled out heading up the backstretch to bid five wide into the far turn then could not get to the winner in the drive. DYNAMICFLOWER broke inward to bump with a rival, was fanned five and six wide through the first turn and moved up late while not a threat to the top pair. B G SISSY'S GIRL was bumped at the break, stalked the pace racing three wide and weakened while gaining position. SHESAWILDGIRL broke to the inside, dueled out from the rail while inside DUSTY'S WAY and had little left in the drive. DUSTY'S WAY dueled outside SHESAWILDGIRL to the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. LADY PEACE was fanned six to seven wide through the first turn and never threatened. DANCE ON THE ICE was forced in at the break, saved ground and tired.
