SONG OF HUMOR broke sharply and moved to the front from outside KALEBS ABLUMIN through the first turn, drew off in hand heading up the backstretch then continued to widen in the lane with the rider showing her whip while in total command. KALEBS ABLUMIN broke on top and contested the lead from inside the winner through the first turn, was soon put away by that one but continued valiantly to save the place. ANOTHER BUMPER bobbled at the break but quickly recovered to settled out from the rail, rallied in the three path through the lane and narrowly missed the place. ARCHULETA saved ground and continued evenly in the lane to gain a position. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR stalked the leaders from the three path to the far turn and weakened. DAN'S THUNDER PLAY dropped well off the pace racing out from the rail then closed the gap on the field late.
