SPRING BLUES made the pace just off the inside while pressured throughout, shook off challenges in the second and the final turns to move clear into the lane and held sway under steady handling. SEAL OF THE PEARL settled outside off the early pace, moved up going to the far turn to bid five wide and edged clear for the place while no threat to the winner. C O STEPHEN prompted the pace from between rivals and weakened in the drive. FIRE UP THE BELL saved ground to late backstretch, angled five wide in the far turn then was bumped nearing the lane as a rival came out and moved up while no threat. DEVIL WATER stalked the pace from four wide, came out late in the far turn to bump with a rival and moved up while no threat. PRIME REALESTATE prompted the early pace while four and five wide, settled back on the second turn then rallied back into the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. BAD BIG AL stalked the pace from three wide and weakened. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM moved up four wide in the second turn to challenge then tired nearing the lane.
