Footnotes

HUXLEY HALL stalked the pace, moved up to take command through the far turn, drifted in the stretch and stayed well clear under steady pressure. ALKINOOS reared at the start, raced three wide and gained ground in the final stages. TOP OF THE HERD was slow early, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and gained ground in the final stages. TANNA GOLD was fractious in the gate, pressed the pace and tired. PROUD VENTURE raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. WONDER ROCK raced four wide and never was a factor. RICK'S WONDERBOY showed little. POWDER RIVER CAT failed to menace. CALLER BLOCKED was bumped at the start and never threatened.
