DONNAGUSKA moved to challenge from outside MS. BUMPER heading up the backstretch while four to five wide, was roused in the bend to put that one away then drew off and was under a pull through the final sixteenth while winning with something in reserve. MS. BUMPER moved up from the four path to bid with the winner midway of the backstretch, dueled that one through the far turn then could not match strides in the lane while well clear for her position. MARINA NOLAN saved ground in reach of the pace then continued evenly to hold position while unable to go with the top pair. LIGHT SWEET CRUDE rushed up along the inside to gain the early lead, was quickly headed by the top pair heading up the backstretch and tired. RED HEADED WOMAN lunged at the break and was always back racing three to four wide. THIS TIME BABY lunged at the break then was trying to get out in the first turn and never threatened.
