HE'S NO JOKE dueled on the pace from inside rivals throughout, continued well in the drive and prevailed after a long drive. FORTY BELOW dropped back off the pace racing three wide, rallied in the far turn then ran up the heels of an injured foe and checked hard to nearly lose all momentum, came out for the drive and closed with a strong late run to be quickly getting to the winner. C O CODNER was four and five wide through the first turn, settled three wide heading up the backstretch, moved inside for the drive and closed then was outfinished for position late. SMOAKBOX dueled from four wide outside rivals, continued well into the lane then weakened a bit late. TRIPSTAR was outrun for a half mile racing well out in the track, swung seven wide into the lane and made a belated run. LUM stalked the pace from four wide, altered course out to be six wide into the lane to avoid the injured foe and weakened. KEEPING SECRETS saved ground in good position but weakened. SKYS DOWN dueled from between rivals to midway of the far turn, went lame then broke down while pulling up in the stretch.
