Footnotes

STARSOVERPARADISE stalked the pace, moved up along the inside in the stretch and finished gamely to get up under strong pressure. BURIED IN ICE set all the pace from the outside and finished second best. MFAZI stalked the pace, raced three wide and finished willingly to the wire. SECO EXPRESS was slow early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a good late bid. CAMARADERIE was unhurried early, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and gained ground in the final stages. SHARP MOVE saved ground and never was a factor. HARVEST FESTIVAL was slow early, raced five wide in the lane and never threatened. COYANOSA showed little. STORMS OF LIFE showed good speed from the inside and tired. RUN ZOOHA RUN raced wide around the first turn and never menaced.
