Footnotes

SHARP MOVE contested the early lead three wide outside rivals to kick clear heading up the backstretch, was challenged by MFAZI into the lane and kept that one safe under steady urging. MFAZI stalked the leaders from four wide, bid outside the winner into the lane and could not get by while well clear for second. ITTAKESTWOBABY moved up three and four wide to best the others while no threat. TOP OF THE HERD was six wide through the first turn, settled four wide heading up the backstretch and lacked a bid. MY SON JORDAN stalked the pace from three wide and had no rally. THREE CHARMS was not a factor racing three to five wide. COMMAND CAT saved ground to the far turn and was not a threat while angled six wide into the lane. NASTFASTY was five wide in the first turn, angled in through the far turn and weakened in the drive. STORMY DATE showed early speed from between rivals and tired. FORWARD BERNIE showed early speed from along the inside but gave way readily in the far turn.
