GOIN' TO RENO pressed the pace, gained command down the backside, was well clear in the upper stretch and held gamely under mild urging. SHAKE IT HIGH was allowed to settle early, raced along the inside, checked strides nearing the quarter pole, moved up three wide in the stretch and was second best. FLITTER BUG stalked the pace along the inside and lacked a final response in the lane. KAY COLLEEN raced four wide and never menaced. BLIND REALITY pressed the pace and tired. MISS TWO BAGGER raced three wide throughout and never menaced. IMA GRAND GAL was always back. WINDWARD LADY set all the pace and gave way. CRY BABY CRY failed to menace.
