### Footnotes

LIGHT SWEET CRUDE showed the most early speed to cross over and establish position out from the rail, made the pace from the three path heading up the backstretch, shook off her challenger nearing the lane then held safe late. C O BARQUEEN fanned six wide out of the first turn, rallied four and five wide in the far turn and closed through the lane but could not run down the winner. FIREWHIRL took up off heels and altered course outward into the first turn to avoid congestion, rallied three and four wide in the far turn to regain position but could not threaten late. THUNDER GAL saved ground and lacked a closing bid. FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL hesitated and then broke in the air to come away last, drifted out through the first turn, swung widest into the lane and failed to threaten. B G NEW IDEA was carried out by a rival into the first turn, stalked from four wide and weakened. GAMBLING LADY LUCK took up hard as the winner angled in going to the first turn, pressed from outside that one and weakened. The rider of GAMBLING LADY LUCK lodged a claim of foul against the winner alleging interference into the first turn which was not allowed.
