DIAMOND DID IT moved to a short lead along the inside going to the first turn, shook off her challengers through the far turn and moved off in the lane under mild urging. ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE settled four wide to stalk the pace in good position, rallied to the winner in the far turn then could not match strides while holding her position late. RARE ALLY rallied four wide in the far turn and closed from widest through the lane to gain third late. MISS HICKORY broke hard into the side of the gate while showing in front, tracked the winner from three wide and weakened some in the drive. CLASSIC MAURA saved ground and failed to offer a bid. PLAER'S TRUMP failed to mount a rally racing along the inside.
