Footnotes

BRAHMS SONG forced the early pace from outside KISS GONE WILD, bid and edged clear into the lane then held safe late. MY HOMETOWN GAL stalked the pace from four wide while just off the leaders, rallied in the far turn then slowly was getting to the winner late. MELODY RUTH saved ground in good position off the early pace, angled out into the lane and could not produce the needed late run. KISS GONE WILD made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail and inside the winner then weakened late to lose position. ZURI'S GIRL moved up four wide in the far turn but could not threaten late. SWAN'S WING saved ground and weakened. SARATOGA EMBER was six and seven wide in the first turn and had no bid. KAFLEEN was caught up in traffic while five wide in the first turn, fanned eight wide out of that bend and never threatened. HOLYCHOIR fanned six wide out of the first turn then remained outside and weakened. SURFER JET followed the early pace from four and five wide, settled three wide heading up the backstretch, gave way and was easing up through the final yards.
