OH GEE SHE'S GOLD moved to a short clear lead racing out from the rail, made all the running and held sway in the lane under handling. B G COUNTRY GIRL saved ground just off the early pace, got nearest the winner through the far turn, angled outside for the drive but could not match strides. JULIE C settled just off the early pace, angled five wide going to the far turn and moved up but could not threaten the top pair. AFLEET LEA stalked the pace from four wide and weakened in the drive. U LITTLE DEVIL U stalked the pace from five wide, bid into the far turn and weakened. S D P BROOKLYN was bumped between rivals at the start then drifted seven wide out of the first turn, remained wide and could not threaten. RUBY RED GREEN broke outward and bumped with a rival, pressed the early pace from three or four wide and weakened. SAMI'S IN TROUBLE broke inward to bump with a rival, saved ground and was not a factor. TRINAS THREE D'S saved ground and tired.
