Footnotes

CHUNK prompted the pace from outside GOLDEN CEDAR while never far back, was taken outside to avoid a rival into the far turn and lost ground, rallied back boldly into the lane and moved clear under steady urging. STELLAR PRINCESS stalked the pace racing three and four wide, moved between rivals and bumped with GOLDEN CEDAR going to the far turn, challenged outside TROPHY CLUB then bumped with that one entering the lane, continued on willingly but could not go with the winner. GOLDEN CEDAR moved to a clear lead racing out from the rail early, bumped with the place horse in late backstretch as the field bunched, rallied back outside in the lane and just missed the place. SCHOOL'S OUT saved ground racing off the rail while always in reach but lacked a final closing response. WAYNE A BLUE saved ground and lacked a rally. TROPHY CLUB was angled four wide out of the first turn to stalk the pace in good position, rallied clear in late backstretch with her bid then bumped with the place horse turning for home and weakened.
