PLAN TO WIN stalked the pace from four wide to bid nearing the lane inside the leader as that one drifted then edged clear under steady handling. SHARK TERRITORY contested the pace racing inside rivals and out from the rail then could not go with the winner late. THE GOOD TIME LIME rushed up outside rivals while four and five wide in the first turn to join the duel heading up the backstretch, got clear in the far turn but drifted late in that bend entering the lane and weakened. KAT'S APPROVAL dueled on the pace from between rivals and weakened into the lane. ROYALISM moved up three wide while not a threat. REDNECK IDOL lacked a bid racing four and five wide. SHEZ SEEING STARS saved ground and weakened. SPECIAL PRIZE was not a factor while saving ground.
