Footnotes

SUGARDAZZLE tracked the dueling leaders racing in the five to six path, bid into the far turn and edged clear then held a safe margin under steady handling. SWEN RAY dueled on the pace racing in the three path from inside OURHOPESONSHORTY, continued with the winner to late in the far turn and could not match strides while holding position in the lane. OURHOPESONSHORTY dueled from outside the runnerup, remained a threat to upper stretch and had little left late while holding position. AGGIES RULE followed the pace racing three to four wide and made a mild gain but could not threat late. CATTLE BARON saved ground to the far turn, angled out nearing the lane but had no rally. EWING TIGER failed to offer a bid racing out from the rail. I'M CATTY was not a factor racing four to five wide.
