Footnotes

MOSS BRIDGE moved to a clear lead racing out from the rail, continued well into the lane and dug in late to keep HE CAN DO THAT safe by the narrowest of margins. HE CAN DO THAT came five wide out of the first turn, stalked the pace four wide to bid into the lane but could not get by the winner. PRIMISTALLA dropped back off the early pace, rallied four and five wide through the far turn then continued from widest into the lane and could not get to the top pair. TRIPSTAR was not a factor racing out from the rail. CHATHAM BARS stalked the pace from four wide, angled in going to the far turn and weakened. PALO VERDE tracked the winner's pace early from outside and tired. WHY BE BLUE drifted out badly in the first turn to be about eight wide through most of the bend, rallied back widest going to the far turn and tired while five wide into the lane. I'VE GOT STEAM reared badly then was rank afterwards and never found his stride, pulling up through the first turn.
