TRACK RAIDER lugged in to bump with a rival after the break, settled back off the pace racing four and five wide, moved four wide in the far turn then responded through the lane to rally between rivals and be moving clear. ALMOST SILVER shied inward from a rival at the break to cause congestion, stalked the leaders racing four wide, moved five wide nearing the lane with her bid then could not handle the winner late while just up for the place. LADY SISTER ANNA moved up outside AMY CATHERINE to duel on the pace, continued well into the lane and was outfinished for position late. AMY CATHERINE moved to a clear lead after breaking alertly but was soon joined by LADY SISTER ANNA in the first turn, duelled from inside that one to upper stretch and had little left late. GRANDY DANDY had her rider lose whip then was bumped shortly after the break as the winner came in, stalked the leaders in good position along the inside and weakened. C O JANNIE MAE broke inward, moved up three wide with a mild bid then bumped with HEAVEN'S CORNER nearing the far turn then had no response in the lane. MISS TEN PINS was void of any speed while saving ground and closed a gap late. HEAVEN'S CORNER broke into the side of the gate then came in further after the break, stalked the pace from three and four wide then was bumped into the far turn and dropped out.
