Footnotes

J. R.'S PRIZE contested the pace from between rivals to late backstretch, shook off INDIAN STAR into the far turn then held safe late under steady handling. NOSARA was unhurried early to drop well off the pace while saving ground, looped rivals four wide midway of the far turn then came back to the inside for the drive and closed well late. INDIAN STAR forced the pace from outside the winner to the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. PARKLANE TUACA stalked the pace in good position racing off the rail, moved five wide to mount her bid in the far turn then weakened in the drive. TOPEKA TOAST saved ground in reach of the pace for a half and tired. CRYPTIC SKY tired racing three and four wide. STARLIGHT BABE contested the early lead from inside rivals and tired.
