Footnotes

CLUEMASTER showed speed from four wide between rivals to the first turn, settled back a bit heading up the backstretch and angled outside RUN ZOOHA RUN, bid outside that one into the lane then dug in late as MR EVANS made a late bid and gamely held safe. MR EVANS dropped back off the pace early, angled out heading up the backstretch then made a strong four to six wide move through the far turn into the lane but could not get by the winner. CASE ON ICE settled off the earl pace racing out from the rail, moved three and four wide to challenge through the far turn but could not produce the needed late response in the drive. RUN ZOOHA RUN was caught five wide and outside rivals into the first turn as several went for the lead, continued on to edge clear while three or four wide up the backstretch then weakened in the lane. LUCKY O'BRANNIGAN showed early speed from along the inside and weakened. JADYNS JET vied for the early lead from between rivals and tired. DAN DEE DART vied from between rivals for the early lead and tired.
