WITT'S FAST MAMA tracked the leaders from four wide to bid into the far turn, continued outside in the lane then lugged in and out late but responded to be up in time. WITT'S MIDWAY had the ground break from under to come away awkwardly, recovered to contest the pace from four wide in the first turn, continued out from the rail into the lane then couldn't contain his entymate late. B G WANT ME BACK stumbled at the break, recovered to follow the pace from three wide, rallied in the lane but could not get to the top pair. WITT'S ATTITUDE prompted the pace from along the inside, bid into the far turn then weakened in the lane. B G COUNTRY GIRL angled four wide heading up the backstretch to reach the leaders into the far turn then could not sustain the move. B G GOLDEN SUAVE lacked early speed racing out from the rail, rallied in the far turn then was forced to alter course out about eight wide as a rival came out entering the lane and continued on willingly late. U LITTLE DEVIL U broke outward, was close up along the inside to the far turn, ducked out entering the lane and dropped back. PHARMER BOB hesitated at the break to come away last and trailed the field home.
