ZENA'S AFFAIR made the pace on a short lead from inside TRINAS THREE D'S, was headed by that one in upper stretch but shook off the challenge to move clear in the closing sixteenth under strong urging. TRINAS THREE D'S ducked out at the break but quickly recovered to press the pace from outside the winner, got a head in front through upper stretch then could not match strides the final sixteenth. FIRE N SMOKE was angled out in the first turn to float six wide leaving that bend, angled in going to the far turn and soon lost contact.
