Footnotes

DON'T BLUFF hesitated at the break to come away slowly, saved ground throughout, began picking up rivals through the far turn, angled outside the leaders past midstretch and continued with a good late run to rally clear under steady handling. FROM THE ASHES dueled on a solid pace from outside SUGARDAZZLE throughout, was edging clear of that rival in deep stretch but could not handle the winner's late run. SUGARDAZZLE bumped with a rival at the start, moved up to duel inside FROM THE ASHES on the pace to deep stretch and weakened. RUN FOUR DADDY broke outward, saved ground following the dueling leaders and lacked a closing response. BIG RED FLYER shied from a rival and ducked out at the break, saved ground and lacked a rally. SPEEDY CORVETTE stalked the pace from outside to make his bid five wide heading up the backstretch, reached even terms with the dueling leaders then tired shortly after entering the far turn. ZOOHA THE KING bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the pace from three or four wide and tired.
