SLEW Z COWBOY rallied four and five wide up the backstretch to bid into the far turn, lugged in and brushed with HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY passing the furlong marker, dueled that one the remainder and held. HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY moved up four wide into the far turn with his bid, was brushed as the winner lugged in once straightened, dueled the final furlong but could not get by. SNEAKIE PETESKI settled off the pace racing three and four wide and offered up a mild rally but could not threaten late. SHINY SAND DOLLAR tucked in early to saved ground in reach of the pace, angled out through the lane but lacked a convincing rally. DOWNTOWN BROWN stalked the leaders racing three to four wide and weakened. C D NIGHT angled out heading up the backstretch and moved up six wide into the lane while not a threat. PENNINGTON J. R. forced the early pace from inside LIONS A MARCHEN and tired. B C EXPRESS floated out into the first turn and was always back racing wide. LIONS A MARCHEN showed the most early speed to gain position racing about the three path, made the pace to the far turn and tired. DEWCAN DO IT pulled up lame and was vanned off.
